Dear Parents,

I am pleased to inform you that the Oxford Public School District has met the standards for adequate yearly progress (AYP) for the 2008-2009 school year, based on the Connecticut Mastery Test (CMT) and the Connecticut Academic Performance Test (CAPT) as required under No Child Left Behind (NCLB).

A summary of our district's CMT results are as follows:

Mathematics:

NCLB calls for 82% of our students to be proficient. Our students scored at 94.9% proficient.

Reading:

NCLB calls for 79% of our students to be proficient. Our students scored at 91.6% proficient.

A summary of our CAPT results are as follows:

Mathematics:

NCLB calls for 80% of our students to be proficient. Our students scored at 95.6% proficient.

Reading:

NCLB calls for 81% of our students to be proficient. Our students scored at 96.5% proficient.
